#### **SUBMISSION PROCESS:**

We invite submissions of empirical and theoretical papers spanning the fields of finance, economics, accounting and politics that touch on the broad theme of *Banking and Financial Stability*. The topics of interest include, but are not limited to: Bank risk taking incentives; bank competition; bank ownership; governance, systemic risk and financial regulation; political economy of regulation; government intervention in financial markets; coordination failures, self-fulfilling beliefs, and runs; financial institutions, networks, and contagion; credit markets; household finance; and information disclosure, market discipline; and financial crises and fragility on firms' financing and investment policies. The principal objectives of the meeting are to stimulate policy relevant research in economic science and to generate greater understanding by academic economists of practitioner's environments and vice versa.

Approximately three to four papers from FIRN members will be included on the program.

Interested Authors should submit a full paper including Abstract and Title Page **via the online** research meeting submission portal <u>www.openconf.org/FIRN/</u> no later than close of business Friday, June 2, 2017. Authors will be notified of the decision by Sunday, 2 July, 2017.
