We invite submissions of empirical and theoretical papers spanning the fields of finance, economics, accounting and politics that touch on the broad theme of *Banking and Financial Stability*. The topics of interest include, but are not limited to: Bank risk taking incentives; bank competition; bank ownership; governance, systemic risk and financial regulation; political economy of regulation; government intervention in financial markets; coordination failures, self-fulfilling beliefs, and runs; financial institutions, networks, and contagion; credit markets; household finance; information disclosure and market discipline; financial crises and fragility on firms' financing and investment policies; FinTech and implications for stability; and the impact of climate risks on banks and financial fragility.

The principal objectives of the meeting are to stimulate policy relevant research in economic science and to generate greater understanding by academic economists of practitioner's environments and vice versa.

Interested authors should submit blind copies of their papers via the OpenConf online submission portal – <https://www.openconf.org/FIRN2023/track4/openconf.php> - no later than close of business **Saturday July 8, 2023**.

Authors will be notified of the decision by **August 5**. Interstate presenters and invited discussants will receive reimbursement for their travel and accommodation expenses as determined by the program committee. Travel grants are also being awarded to ECRs to attend the FIRN ECR Workshop—please refer to the Call for Travel Grant Applications for details.
